Introduction

Welcome to your Past Life report. Whereas the birthchart is a symbolic road map describing your current life, the Past Lives chart is a blueprint of your previous incarnations. The pages that follow will help shed some light on themes related to your past life instincts. First, let's talk about reincarnation which is the belief that the current incarnation (as depicted by our birthchart) is linked to the lives that we have previously led. This collection of past influences points to particular experiences you might encounter again so that you can further your growth and fully develop your creative potential. These past impressions go far in shaping many of our current thoughts and choices. There are certain gifts a person seems to possess right out of the womb! It's as though destiny or fate leads one to realize these attributes. Of course, we still have to show ambition and make the effort in order to keep our dreams alive. This report may give confirmation to talents that you already know you have or open your eyes to ones that you have yet to discover.

Our past lives are alive and well in our consciousness. This may already be apparent to you. But on the other hand, these experiences can lie beyond the threshold of our conscious mind's awareness. What is doing the remembering, if our mind isn't? Call it your soul, higher consciousness or whatever explanation feels right to you.

Have you ever heard about karma, that great law of cause and effect? An old timeless saying sums up the whole process: "You reap what you sow." There are actions and thoughts that defined us in other lives, or have guided us to where we are in the present. They don't really exert any control over us. We have freedom of choice. That's a strong message to remember when reading this report.

Also, don't panic if you read something that says you were not a perfect person. Nobody is in the current one! Use the report as a learning tool. The idea is to keep developing and evolving. It's balancing the cosmic rhythm of past and present that presents each of us with a challenge. Do we respond positively or negatively? With hope or doubt? Many of our tendencies are linked to previous incarnations. Certain patterns have likely been by our side over many lifetimes. As we grow and expand our awareness, it becomes very possible to step beyond the trappings of past life baggage.

No doubt you will read various sections that seem to contradict each other. Each could be true about you. It's important to realize that many different dimensions of ourselves live within us. Each of us is composed of memories from so many past lives, combined with an assortment of ways we have learned to deal with reality in this life, that make us complex beings. See which descriptions ring true to you as you read through the following pages. You will notice some traits described have a repeating theme.

I hope you find this report an enjoyable ride into your past life instincts and thought patterns. They are somewhere in your consciousness. Perhaps some of what you read will strike a familiar chord. After all, these pages are all about your past life loves, creative pursuits, adventures, travels, highs and lows, over many lifetimes. Happy navigating!

The Past Life Chart Structure

Some technical explanations about the Past Life chart (if you detest technical discussions, then skip this paragraph and jump right into the report!). The Ascendant in this chart starts with the sign on the cusp of the 12th house, instead of the traditional method of using the sign on the 1st house cusp, which is the sign rising on the eastern horizon at the time of birth. Also, the Past Life birthchart houses are counted clockwise, rather than the conventional way of counterclockwise. In other words, since the 12th house becomes the Ascendant, the sign on the cusp of the 11th house now begins the 2nd house, etc., around the chart wheel. What is considered the Ascendant or 1st house in the traditional chart becomes the 12th in the Past Life chart. Your planets remain in the same sign placements, but now occupy different houses, in this new chart. The planets in signs are interpreted in your report from a past lives perspective.

Something interesting to consider in thinking of the houses in a clockwise direction, they are actually now moving in the same direction as the Nodes of the Moon. As you will read in the report the Moon's nodes are strong past life or karmic points in a chart. Their retrograde motion is clockwise meaning they share the same life biorhythms as the houses of the Past Life chart. By traveling backward, or clockwise, through the houses, you are being regressed back into a past life analysis. Enjoy your ride down memory filled lanes!

The Passport

In this section are the first, middle and last names of your Past Lives astrological identity, the Sun, Moon, and Past Lives Ascendant. Each of these three building blocks will be discussed as to how they actively shaped many of your former lives. But before you meet these three key players, you will start your tour through memory lane with the North Node of the Moon. The North Node contains a special message about what was your overall life purpose. It was a constant rhythm pulsating in your consciousness to keep you on target toward your true purposes. It was a celestial compass trying to guide you to walk your talk with greater clarity. So sit back, and enjoy reading your past lives primer.

Node in Taurus

You had a history of attaining reliable resources. One of your key impulses was seeking comfort and ownership. Your soul was normally patient to reincarnate, knowing that a lifetime of work couldn't be done in a day. The archetypal theme for your destiny was to be a stabilizing force. A crucial lesson was not to get stuck. Becoming too attached to what you tasted, touched, smelled and owned kept you from expanding your growth. When you found ways to increase your wealth, it brought you great satisfaction.

There were times you were drawn into the danger lanes. A trickster was telling yourself that whatever came easy was not to be trusted. Life seemed an endless struggle. Finding a way to balance a sober outlook with seeking extreme intensity was a key to your fulfillment. Finding contentment with your desire nature regularly played a major role in your incarnations. You needed to know that you could trust someone with your deepest secrets and with your possessions. Claiming your own power in relationships and in other endeavors, shed great illumination. Betrayal by those you confided in threw you off course. Turning to your own values and resourcefulness pointed the way to wholeness. A tendency to explore life's mysteries deepened your understanding and taught you how to convert negatives into positives.

Node in 2nd house

What types of activities did you participate in that furthered your soul growth? When you relaxed into roles that best expressed your potentials you were on top of the world. You found that compulsively forcing yourself to be someone you weren't, made you unhappy. A common concern was "how can I develop my real talents?" When you were patient in reaching your objectives, you more easily managed to stay out of karma's way. What sorts of experiences motivated you? Your energy levels peaked when earning money, and being with partners awakened your passion. Giving up your power too easily is what took the air out of your sails. Empowering relationships and pursuing paths leading to self-mastery were how you enjoyed feeling more in control of your destiny. Seeking equality and experiences that deepened your mind, kept you on track as much as becoming too bossy made you seem repulsive. Somewhere always hiding in the caverns of your memory banks were stabilizing instincts mixed with a

tinge of an attraction to extremes. When using them wisely and advantageously, life was colored with senseless acts of beauty and a great determination that took you over the mountains of ambition.

Sun: Creativity, Ego, Self-expression

Sun in Leo:

The sign of Leo the lion lighted the mid-summer astrological skies at your birth into this life. Let's explore what significance this had in regard to your past lives. In traditional astrology the keyword phrase for Leo is "I create". You had a repeating pattern about getting your message out there to others in a dramatic way. Promoting yourself, or those you loved, was a trait carried over from one lifetime to another. A dynamic will power paved the way for success. Your ego got bruised when you didn't feel you received your just rewards. A craving for attention made you somewhat vulnerable to the wishes of others.

Archetypes for Leo include the Queen, King, actor, and promoter. Power was an issue. Your lifetimes found you assuming too little or too much. When you were balanced in the wise use of authority your relationships and life in general were more harmonious.

The cosmic principle at work through many of your past incarnations was to push yourself to maximum overdrive. You weren't always a type A personality. You had a habit of not stopping until you finished what you started. When you realized you couldn't get your own way on all occasions, you were more fun to know. You found ego strength through self-expression. You came into this life solarized through a sign promoting a multitude of get up and go. Vitality was a gift. Growing too attached to creations was a shadow. Letting others express their own personal attributes was a key to your self-mastery. It was when you acted with courage and with a willingness to listen to the heartbeat of those you loved that you were truly adored.

Sun in 12th house

You had solar power heating your idealism in a big way in past lives. A desire to make your dreams come true was ever present. Faith could move mountains in your eyes. Your intuitive voice often whispered words of inspiration to your conscious mind, that is, if you could hear them. Your creative vitality fed off of your imagination. In some lives you had avid interest in the arts. Aligning your mind with your spiritual beliefs gave you an energy boost. Expectations had to be reality-tested to ensure you were asking for the possible. The irony was that when you went beyond the ordinary is when you were unusually lucky. Pride in your highest values was shown. You liked those able to fulfill a promise.

If there was a challenge it was escapism. Running away from conflict caused problems. When you faced life directly, you made yourself and others happy in the long haul. You were often a romantic. Love and soul mates constantly knew your name. It was defining clearly what you needed that became important. Guilt and self-pity depleted your clarity. Gaining objective distance from problems was a must. Healing energy emanated from you, but you needed to be aware of your boundaries. Your self-expression flourished through your ideals. You found fulfillment through helping others transcend their limitations, and in sharing your life with those understanding your intuitive hunger.

Moon: Sense of Security, Roots, Feelings

Moon in Capricorn:

You were lunarized at birth through the sign of Capricorn. What does this say about your past life tendencies? An instinctual desire to trust the safety of structure as a means to success followed you from one incarnation to another. The family ancestries in past lives were linked by a serious acceptance of responsibility and ambitious drives.

Your inner landscapes were colored by a hard-working nature. Fear was the stumbling block that got in your way. When you conquered self-doubt just enough to break free, you found your true paths. You could be quite reserved, even shy, until getting to know someone. It's possible that you felt younger as you became older! You were a reliable sort. Some may have found you a little strict. The less control you exhibited, the closer loved ones came to you.

You enjoyed solitude as the atmosphere spoke to your soul. You rose into leadership positions because people trusted you. You reached the top of a profession through steady patience. Delayed gratification was not that hard for you. Being too conservative when it came to taking a risk did cost you an opportunity or two. Depression was a challenge. It was important that you didn't make your work your whole life. Another strong theme was leadership. Your subconscious called to you to stay clear of becoming rigid, and let the voice of your intuition speak as loudly as your pragmatic side.

Moon in 7th house

Mercury in Cancer

Helping fulfill the hopes of others made you feel good. You valued truth and a sense of unity. Helping those you loved find ways to make their dreams come true, meant a lot to you.

Mars: Assertion, Courage, Identity

Mars in Gemini

Jupiter in 8th house

Although there were times when you regretted not focusing on one major undertaking at a time. The Journey

Saturn: Ambition, Seriousness, Focus, Responsibility

Saturn in Leo

Ambition came through you with thunderous force, says your past lives history, with Saturn placed in the dramatic sign of Leo. Discipline followed after you plunged passionately into your most creative endeavors. You didn't like taking a backseat to anyone. Pride in your accomplishments was your style. It didn't hurt your feelings if people applauded loudly. The rub was when they didn't acknowledge your talents quickly enough. But let it be said you were willing to cheer on others in return. Your greatest fear was rejection. It devastated you, especially in romance. When you realized that not everyone would love you unconditionally, guess what happened? You found happiness faster.

A karmic shadow was being too overconfident in some lives, while lacking ego strength in others. How could both be possible? There were times when you steam rolled your desires over others. Then there were lives when you lacked belief in your ability to the point of hiding your talent. Finding that middle ground of inner faith took you out of this challenge. You often defined yourself through professions allowing you to exercise your full creative capacity, and as someone with an endless amount of vitality.

Saturn in 11th house

What was your main focus? Carving out dependable future goals. You consistently asked at crucial points during an incarnation: What are the shortest steps to success? Baby ones usually became even more the reality. You scared easy if you thought failure was that snake waiting in the grass. Having control over your autonomy was important. You didn't always know how to exert your independence, but could be stubborn in resisting those trying to decide for you. Loosening up actually made you feel years younger. A major redefining occurred in lifetimes when you ran into obstacles bigger than you. This was when you often discovered the true paths through painfully reinventing yourself. Wisdom came through knowing which rules were worth following without question, and those that needed to be interpreted in a way that they might better serve your purpose.

Uranus: Individuality, Goals, Uniqueness, Freedom

Uranus in Gemini

You had a tendency to think excitedly about future goals, indicates having Uranus in the sign Gemini. Your mind did switch to fast forward when talking about ideas and when getting an opportunity to learn new information. Communication was an arena that you knew well. Uranus in 1st house

In what way were you unconventional? It was in terms of your identity and personal style. This was how you often reinvented yourself and found the courage to have futuristic vision. Ideas shot through you like heat seeking missiles. They followed the minds of others until penetrating their targets. You were impulsive in putting your goals into action. As a matter of fact, you felt stuck at step one when lacking a sense of direction. Being independent was spontaneous. You were quite outspoken for personal autonomy. Doing the same routines never made your day a memorable experience. Variety in all of its wonderful shapes and forms was your first choice. You didn't normally consider the consequences of your actions. You weren't one to compromise your freedom, which incidentally was your lifeline. You needed more latitude than many to seek self-discovery. You became inventive when you broke the shackles of your own self-doubts.

Neptune: Idealism, Romanticism, Intuition, Dreams, Escapism

Neptune in Libra

You believed in ideals that symbolized fairness and justice for all. Your idealism was awakened through the individuals believing in you, and the ones you admired. Talents in the arts were shown in several lives. You liked individuals possessing diplomacy and tact. Stress annoyed you if lasting too long. Denying there was any problems never resolved anything. Romance was a great calling. Love was almost a religion. You liked exotic partners and those willing to move quickly in an atmosphere of celebration. Falling in love with a lack of reality testing was not in your best interest.

A major challenge was in defining the boundaries between you and others. Guilt made you feel too responsible for a person's troubles. Wearing rose colored glasses painted false first impressions of individuals, letting you see what only you chose to perceive. There were times

when you could see right into the soul of someone. When you were honest with yourself, you gravitated to the right peers and lovers. You wanted from the deepest part of your soul to get opportunities to express your gifts and to find a special someone that recognized the true you. You found transcendental growth through not trying to overly please others, and by having the faith to proceed ahead with your most determined effort.

Neptune in 9th house

In what way were you extra intuitive? It was in regard to having long range outlooks. You could see miles and miles ahead of many. It was those nasty little details that were a nuisance. Going to foreign places and meeting people from various locations mesmerized you. It was getting out of your home terrain that made you feel special. Your idealism caused you to seek growth through education and learning. You had a strong inclination to teach. Sharing your understanding with others was fulfilling. Being a counselor or advisor came naturally.

A test was in not becoming so expansive that you never focused on immediate needs. You were accused of lacking commitment. Though you rationalized this as being distracted by other interests. You did often manage to reach great heights when you felt the inspiration of your beliefs. When you tapped into a positive attitude it wasn't easy to talk you out of a choice, whether a good one or bad. Your spirituality was usually cherished. You had an eclectic belief system. What was the biggest challenge? It was in how you responded after an extreme disappointment. Not wanting to face your loss of hope made matters worse. Faith transformed your denial into a renewed positive thinking. You searched for a purpose that had open-ended questions that gave you the opportunity to keep seeking growth-promoting answers.

Pluto: Personal Power, Self-mastery, Rebirth, Loss, Passion

Pluto in Leo

Empowering yourself through creative risk-taking was a past lives tendency. A strong drive to make your plans ring true was forever pulsating through you. Finding pride through giving birth to ideas was a regular pattern. Cheering and promoting emanated from you loudly. You shined brightly with charisma when your accomplishments were recognized. Your enthusiasm often swept people into believing in you. Growing too attached to what you loved was an occasional downfall. Maintaining some objective distance from lovers and your creations made you easier to like.

There was a shadow. What was it? A fear of losing. When your skin toughened up enough to at least accept a small dose of rejection, you didn't suffer as much. You could fight endlessly to make others accept your proposals and deals. In the end, you had to decide which battles to wage. In some incarnations you actually lacked the confidence to be successful. Therefore, in this latter case you had to find ways to allow the talent to develop. Self-mastery was discovered through allowing authentic self-expression beam brightly from you. You found rebirth or a sense of renewal when listening to your heart, rather than the fear of your self-doubt.

Pluto in 11th house

How did you go about seeking personal empowerment? You latched onto those goals that set you as free as Jonathan Livingston Seagull, flying high above the crowd. A renewed sense of purpose was discovered through meeting individuals that stimulated you to breathe with a greater spirit. Getting refocused in a more creative direction was usually the answer. A get off of my cloud mentality didn't always make you popular, but gave you the room to test the depths of your own waters. You weren't one to rush into experimenting with new things, until being assured there were no strings too tightly attached. A powerful self-examination manifested if you became too self-focused. Forgetting to support the ideas of others caused tension. A compulsive tendency to control the movement of others, or they acting like this toward you, got you to ask thought-provoking questions. Power struggles over money were not uncommon. A shadow frequently followed you into incarnations linked to being too cold emotionally or distant. When you thawed out the ice, you enjoyed closer relationships.

Footnotes

You have already been introduced to the ten planets. Certain planetary pairs in your chart have a special relationship to one another due to particular angular distances separating them, known as aspects. You could say the two planets in an aspect travel and interact together along the same circuit. The following aspects will be listed under five types. Two are known as the soft aspects: the sextile (60 degrees) and trine (120 degrees). These two aspects generally point to more gentle themes, and therefore will describe past life trends that went very well for you. They indicate a lower voltage of electricity and produced less friction in your mind and through your actions. The planets involved in a trine or sextile are more likely to talk about areas where you flowed without much effort.

The more hard or intense aspects are the conjunction (0 degrees), square (90 degrees) and opposition (180 degrees). They required your best understanding in past lives. Planets that are part of an intense aspect you will notice often indicate lessons that must be learned, and follow us from one incarnation into another until we get them in balance. These higher voltage aspects don't mean the planets operated negatively, only that there was much more force behind them. "Soft" does not mean good and "intense" does not imply bad. It is often the more intense aspects that deepen our soul growth, that is, if we learn how to use their power wisely. If we don't it's like taking one step forward and three back.

It might be helpful to keep some keywords in mind for the aspects. The sextile represents Excitation and Eagerness. The planets in this aspect give clues as to how their energies worked in a stimulating way through you. The trine is a special Harmony. The two planets involved show you were confident of their interacting energies. The conjunction is where two planets are joined at the hip. There is a Fusion or powerful blending of these energies. The square can reveal where you encountered Friction. Pay special attention to these aspects in particular because they denote themes that are strong past patterns. Squares ask us to resolve their conflict by finding creative outlets. The opposition requires a Balancing act. It is similar to a seesaw. Gaining objective awareness about each planet is a key. Remember, it was usually the most intense aspects that stretched you the most in past lives.

Moon square Neptune

You had a strong tendency to ignore reality though this doesn't necessarily mean the news was all bad. Some of your greatest accomplishments came through testing the utmost limits of your imagination. The muse consciousness regularly called your name. An intense desire to master a creative expression occurred frequently. Yes, you were a dreamer. This caused you to ignore many of the warning posts signaling that maybe you were swimming out into treacherous waters. A wish for escape made you try to do things others shied away from. Tasting the best that life had to offer was another offshoot. A battle with extreme pulls toward perfection and denial had to be won. The search for the ideal love was on early. Though you were happier when realizing that all relationships took work. Having clearly defined boundaries was a test.

Sun conjunct Saturn

You were all business when you needed to be. Determining where to put your best effort was challenging. How you dealt with success and failure was a key to happiness. Celebrating the milestones was a pleasant relief because it meant all of your hard work paid off. It was rejection that dampened your spirits, sometimes causing depression. Issues with your father followed you from one incarnation to another. It doesn't mean this was always a bad relationship, only that it was a sensitive one. Professional ambition was a big player. The work ethic was intense. A slow steady effort toward your desired aims clicked. Fear is what got in the way, the kind that chills us to the bone. Overcoming anxiety about displaying your ability was vital to realizing your happiness. You had power when you tapped into your strength. Trying to prove something to others never really was all that productive. You were not the best in revealing your feelings or in delegating jobs to others. When you relaxed into the roles you enjoyed, life was flowing. Wisdom came from learning through experiences. The wise use of power kept you free from many unnecessary struggles.

Sun conjunct Pluto

If you're reading this one, you know you were deep! Each incarnation put you through one test after another. There were secrets you only revealed to a chosen few, or to nobody. You expressed great passion. It was hard for you not to get too attached to what you loved. Running into possessive individuals now and then did occur. When you forced others to play by your rules, it wasn't as rewarding as when trusting them to do so. You didn't like being pressured into decisions. Having things on your own terms was more like it. Dealing with extremes was old business. It was your resilience that separated you from many. Overcoming adversity made you a tower of strength. Learning the art of forgiveness worked wonders. The clear expression of power helped avoid struggles. You did need to keep a watchful eye on those capable of betrayal. The mysteries of life fascinated you, and deepened your awareness.

Mercury trine Jupiter

You had an even keel life philosophy, not wanting to let the unexpected blow you out of the water. It was possible to talk your way out of just about anything. You did sometimes deny reality because it seemed like too much trouble. A positive attitude brought you good luck more often than not.

Mars conjunct Uranus

Wow! If you are reading this one then you were typically someone fast on the draw. You didn't wait around for permission to do your own thing. You were more like a rebel, sometimes with a real cause, and at other times with no plan in mind. "Rules were made to be broken" was your motto. Consistency wasn't your strong point. Unpredictability was what was predictable. If you did accept responsibility or found a way to get focused, you surprised others with how much you could accomplish. You liked being where the action was. Accident proneness did wreak havoc on your body. It was a lack of regard for playing it safe that caused these

calamities. In a few lives your nervous system was extremely high strung. You sometimes had to pull back from conflict to get clear enough as to how to respond clearly. People expected to see angry outbursts. You were a maverick early on in search of electrifying experiences.

Mars conjunct Ascendant

Assertiveness was never that much of a problem. You were usually ready to charge ahead at a moment's notice. Finding ways to express a dynamo of energy was the challenge. Patience was your greatest test. You could become consumed with your own needs. People liked you more when you acted interested in their goals. You had a real thing about your identity. There was a tendency to keep trying to prove you were a winner. There was a competitor in you that hated to lose. You initiated quite well but didn't necessarily finish, unless real interested in the project. Utilizing anger needed your wisest discretion.

Jupiter square Saturn

Happy one day and sad the next. This was a pattern in some lives. You lived in extremes. Finding that place in between great joy and sober reality was the challenge. You had high expectations. Authority figures clashed with your optimism. You needed to be careful not to automatically dash someone else's hopes and dreams with negativity. The work world got you to pin many of your dreams on it. This worked fine when you were a success. It was depressing when you failed. Having beliefs that sustained you in the lean seasons was paramount in importance. You had a conflict when you dreadfully feared losing. Taking small clear steps toward a plan often delivered the best results. Not taking yourself so seriously helped. Learning to live in the moment rather than making delayed gratification your god opened the door to happiness. Becoming disciplined with an understanding that enjoying the journey was just as important as the result saved you!

Jupiter square Pluto

You were forceful in getting your own way. This wasn't so bad when you needed to ward off your enemies. Trusting someone didn't come easy, and they had better prove their worth. When you were dedicated to a set of principles or a belief, you fought to the death for it. Starting over after a disaster occurred often. Sometimes this released great creative energy, especially if you didn't lament endlessly over what you lost. If you resisted facing a challenge it only prolonged the agony. You were resilient and very resourceful. When you learned that it wasn't productive to compulsively worry, you were better off. You found power in gaining knowledge. Forgiveness was healing.

Saturn conjunct Pluto

Watching extremes was what you needed to do. Compulsive urges for power sometimes took you to great heights and in some ways met with self-destruction. The wise use of power was the best road to success. You made long lasting pacts with partners. Trust was the big story. You enjoyed great loyalty, but then again you had to watch your back, as betrayal was

inevitable. Why? It was usually related to people envious of your position in life. They wanted what you had. Knowing who were your friends and identifying clearly who wasn't was vital. Professional ambition was intense. Whatever roles you took on, you put out great effort. Your expectations of others were tough. Becoming more lenient with loved ones was the way to bring them closer. Learning how to forgive kept relationships going longer. You possessed a mental toughness that wasn't afraid of challenges. What you couldn't control, you needed to learn how to accept, or it eventually destroyed you. Your contemporaries found you to be self-sufficient. When you discovered your life passions, it was a sense of freedom. Self-mastery came when feeling fully empowered.

Midheaven square Node

If you are reading this one, then you don't need to be reminded again that your most serious focuses always became the bread and butter of fulfillment. When not challenged, an inner conflict tormented you. Your intuition made a pact with reality that you would work hard as long as you got to play. Balancing the needs of profession and family were quite a challenge. You wanted both in a big way. Pleasing each tore you apart if not staying true to your own soul growth. People took notice of your accomplishments, sometimes giving you more recognition than you gave yourself. Making peace with the past freed you in the present and launched the magic of the future.

Just as the Ascendant in the Passport section that began this report was described as a sign serving a special purpose, each of the other eleven houses has a sign that helps define its meaning. What follows is a trip through each of the other past lives houses or environments to give you a view of additional characteristics. First are listed the keywords for each house.

2nd House: Comfort, values, money, ownership.

Taurus on 2nd house:

Steady patience was a great ally. Business sense was something you usually possessed. Life went well when you had high self-esteem. Making sure you rewarded yourself when working hard always paid dividends. You eventually found the kind of work that best made a statement about your ability. Though sometimes a fear of change held you back. You were happier and more fun to be around when indulging in a new experience now and then.

3rd House: Perceptions, learning, communication, insight.

Pisces on 3rd house:

You followed your feelings and intuitive impulses. They guided your perceptions. If emotionally confused, you didn't think so clearly. So it was important not to let other's opinions bother you. Your mind worked romantically. Looking through rose colored glasses did lead you astray from time to time. Then again your mental impulses could tune right into the truth. Accepting what you really saw took courage. Because you could detect what was really going on in the minds of other people, you had to decide just how much you wanted to know. Denial kept you from clarity. Speaking directly to those you loved came with practice. Standing up to

your critics and adversaries grew when you embraced with greater fortitude your most cherished ideals. Certain causes spoke directly to your heart. You absorbed a lot of other people's energies so downtime was essential. Guilt was a shadow that was tormenting. When you found the faith to let go of self-doubt, the heavens seemed to shine down with good fortune.

4th House: Home, security, nurturing, roots.**Aquarius on 4th house:**

Closeness and distance was a challenge. You liked the feeling of companionship and a trusted partner. Then again, you liked your breathing room. Balancing these two tendencies wasn't easy. You had to find the courage to let your unique ideas be known. Your sense of security leaned on your determination to be a free and independent thinker. Showing others you needed them brought them closer. If you became too distant emotionally, life was a lonelier place. Clearly established dependency needs proved wise.

5th House: Self-expression, creativity, confidence, romance, risk-taking.**Aquarius on 5th house:**

You boldly expressed ideas. You could be fair on one hand, while arrogant on the other. When it came to defending your rights, you could be quite direct. Inventiveness often blessed you in one life after another. Romances had their ups and downs. You were not always sure just how committed to a lover you cared to be. Freedom needs dictated just how you responded to a partner. You demanded a lot of attention. Developing consistency didn't come easily. When you managed to master your rebellious energy, you could channel it into productive outlets quite successfully. You lived much of the time for your future goals. The present was more tolerable if it met the expectations of your need for opportunity. Some saw you as unreasonable because you hated restrictions. Others envied and admired in the same breath the example you set as far as walking your talk.

6th House: Learning skills, work environment, perfection, diet, health.**Capricorn on 6th house:**

You applied yourself seriously to the job in front of you. Discipline along with a hard work ethic guided much of your thinking. Becoming a workaholic occurred. You did need to discover that delegating work to others did lighten your load. A tendency to try to do too much of the work on your own grew burdensome. Trusting others to help became a wise policy. Your determination got you over obstacles.

7th House: Relationships, marriage, partnerships, social awareness.**Sagittarius on 7th house:**

You liked adventurous types. Falling in love was exhilarating. An attraction to broad-minded individuals was a reality. You liked being with someone sharing your values and

world-view. An idealistic nature colored the lenses through which you perceived a lover. This doesn't mean you were gullible. You realized that not everyone could be trusted. Your belief in people raised their spirits. Relationships that offered growth caught your attention. Lovers could be changeable and at times not so reliable. You may have had too much faith in them. If someone didn't try to control you, he or she scored points. You did sometimes have a grass is greener outlook, causing you to suddenly leave a lover. Fun loving individuals lifted you out of your lows. You became bored with those that were negatively addicted. Luck more often than not brought you good fortune in meeting the right people at the right time. You could be spontaneous in moving toward a door of opportunity. A gregarious nature brought you into contact with an interesting assortment of peers.

**8th House: Power, joint resources, rebirth, passion, self-mastery.
Scorpio on 8th house:**

The sharing of money and power had to be handled carefully. Knowing whom to trust was a test. Extreme jealousy needed to be moderated. An attachment to the wrong types of people made life difficult. However, when you selected the right partners, you were on top of the world. Dealing with possessive individuals was never easy. You had to learn how to claim your own power. Privacy was dear to your soul. You needed a retreat at times to keep your psyche strong and clear. When you kept life simple, it was easier to be happy. You didn't tend to trust others that quickly. It generally took time to draw close, no matter if the relationship got off to a passionate start. You usually wanted to convince yourself that you could make it on your own. A self-sufficient spirit was with you often. You felt better about joining forces with others, after being sure of your own autonomy.

**9th House: travel, learning, philosophy, knowledge, optimism.
Virgo on 9th house:**

A sober philosophy about life is what you showed. If someone wanted a grounded opinion, you were definitely the person to ask. You preferred to spend your time on practical concerns. It's not that you didn't have any idealism or intuition, but it's more likely these two traits were not the first choice. You carefully weighed your options before making decisions. Impulsive individuals made you nervous. Even your recklessness appears to have been well thought out. Conquering negative thinking made the present more enjoyable as did maintaining a broader perspective.

**10th House: Professions, ambition, leadership, focus, commitments.
Leo on 10th house:**

Leadership roles made you feel you were in the driver's seat. People either liked the way you took control of situations or were angered by it. Either way, you did exert a very visible presence when you were determined to make your ideas known. Taking pride in your accomplishments defined you. What might have gone wrong with this dynamic energy? It was not knowing when to stop forcing your will on others. A steady and focused movement toward ambitions was your usual mode of operation. Having things on your own terms was what you preferred. People wished you didn't always have to get your own way. Finding a big enough

stage to act out roles was a constant challenge. You had to fight those trying to limit your self-expression. Not having your talents noticed was always a bitter pill to swallow. You normally didn't wait for others to take notice. You were delighted when loved ones showed unconditional faith in your abilities. You showed impatience with those doubting you. Lack of success wasn't in your vocabulary.

11th house: Goals, individuality, freedom, inventive, progressive, unique.**Leo on 11th house:**

You approached the future like it was something to conquer. You would roar like a lion when people were infringing upon your rights. Anyone squatting too far into your territory was looking for a fight. Your goals were characteristically self-centered. This didn't bother your lovers and closest friends as long as you weren't too ruthless in going after your aspirations. Your vision could be disruptive of the routines of those not liking your suggestions. Patience was a challenge. In a lifetime or two you were a notorious gambler. Learning to look before leaping was wise. Getting close to you was not all that easy when you were too much in love with your independence. 12th house: Idealism, intuition, escape, faith, beliefs.**Cancer on 12th house:**

You preferred not being all that visible. When there was vagueness in making your needs known, confusion resulted. You tended to idealize your closest relationships. This did lead you to sometimes expect too much from people. It was your inspiring belief in those you cared about that did get them to attempt great things. Learning how to regulate closeness and distance in relating to others kept you balanced. Having confidence in your deepest beliefs brought you fulfillment.
